Schemes for Promoting of Fisheries

†4964. Shri Rajkumar Roat:

Will the Minister of FISHERIES, ANIMAL HUSBANDRY AND DAIRYING be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of total budget assigned and grants released by the Government during the last five years under various schemes for promoting fisheries, scheme, State and category-wise,
- (b) whether the Government provides boats, nets and other facilities to fishermen or committees for fisheries, if so, the details thereof;
- (c) the details of benefits availed by them during the last five years, State and year-wise;
- (d) whether the Government proposes to strengthen the committees formed earlier for promoting fisheries in Mahi and Kadana dams located in Rajasthan and provide them boats, nets and other facilities; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

ANSWER

**MINISTER OF STATE FOR FISHERIES, ANIMAL HUSBANDRY AND DAIRYING
(SHRI GEORGE KURIAN)**

(a) to (c): The Department of Fisheries, Ministry of Fisheries, Animal Husbandry and Dairying, Government of India with effect from the financial year 2020-21 has been implementing a flagship scheme the Pradhan Mantri Matsya Sampada Yojana (PMMSY) in all States and Union Territories for holistic development of fisheries and aquaculture sector in the country. During the last four years (2020-21 to 2023-24) and current year(2024-25), the Department of Fisheries, Ministry of Fisheries, Animal Husbandry and Dairying has accorded approvals to the fisheries developmental proposals of various State Governments, Union Territories (UTs)and other implementing agencies amounting to Rs.20,990.79 crore with central share of Rs.8926.28 crore under the Pradhan Mantri Matsya Sampada Yojana (PMMSY). State-wise details of projects, central funds approved and central fund released under Pradhan Mantri Matsya Sampada Yojana during the last four years and current year are furnished at Annexure-I.

The Pradhan Mantri Matsya Sampada Yojana(PMMSY) *inter-alia* provides boats and nets to traditional fishermen and also other facilities to fishermen, fish famers and other stake holders for development of fisheries and livelihood support. State-wise details of boats and nets provided to traditional fishermen under PMMSY are furnished at Annexure-II.

The other key facilities approved under PMMSY for providing to fishers, fish farmers and other stake holders include; 32051 hectares of aquaculture area, support for upgradation of existing 1338 fishing vessels, support for seaweed and bivalve cultivation, 983 hatcheries, 25 Brood Banks, 12081 Re-circulatory Aquaculture Systems(RAS), 4205 biofloc units, 55118 reservoir cages, 1525 open sea cages, 5711 raceways and 560.70 hectares pens in reservoirs, 634 ice plants/cold storages, 1091 feed mills/plants, 202 retail fish markets, 6694 fish kiosks, 27189 units of fish transportation facilities, 128 value added enterprise units and 644 ornamental fisheries units. In addition, for better social safety, insurance coverage to an average 32.82 lakh fishers annually with no contribution from beneficiaries, livelihood and Nutritional support to an average 5.95 lakh fishers annually were provided during the last four years (2020-21 to 2023-24) and current year (2024-25) under PMMSY.

(d) to (e): The Government of Rajasthan has reported that during the financial year 2021-22, a total 93 number of boats and 1853 kg of nets have been distributed to tribal fishermen located in Mahi Bajaj Sagar. The Government of Rajasthan has further reported that tribal fishermen residing near Mahi Bajaj Sagar and Kadana Bank water are also provided the Group Accidental Insurance coverage and an average 159 tribal fishermen in Mahi Bajaj Sagar and 319 tribal fishermen in Kadana Bank water are provided insurance coverage annually during last five years (2020-21 to 2024-25).
