PRADHAN MANTRI KAUSHAL VIKAS YOJANA (PMKVY) IN KARNATAKA

2716. SHRI YADUVEER WADIYAR:

Will the Minister of SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP be pleased to state:

- (a) the total number of youth who have been trained under the Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana (PMKVY), State-wise particularly in Karnataka;
- (b) whether the Government has proposed new skill training centres for emerging sectors like IT and green technologies, in said State, if so, district-wise details thereof;
- (c) the steps being taken by the Government to enhance industry participation in skill development initiatives; and
- (d) the details of the measures introduced by the Government to promote self-employment and entrepreneurship among youth?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE (INDEPENDENT CHARGE) IN THE MINISTRY OF SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP

(SHRI JAYANT CHAUDHARY)

(a) The State-wise number of candidates trained under Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana, since inception as on 31.12.2024, is given at *Annexure I*.

(b) As the PMKVY is demand driven, training centres (TCs) are empanelled/engaged on need basis to impart the training across the country. The PMKVY 4.0 has focused on introducing courses relevant to emerging technology and Industry 4.0, such as AI, robotics, green hydrogen, environmental sustainability, mechatronics, IoT, 3D printing, drone technology, etc. Till date, National Council for Vocational Education and Training (NCVET) has approved around 540 futuristic job roles in various sector including emerging sectors like IT and green technologies.

In the State of Karnataka, training have been imparted in 27 futuristic job roles such as Drone Manufacturing and Assembly Technician, IoT Hardware Analyst, Additive Manufacturing (3D Printing), AI - Machine Learning Engineer, etc. The district-wise number of candidates trained in futuristic job roles under PMKVY 4.0, as on 31.12.2024, in the State of Karnataka is given at *Annexure II*.

(c) To enhance industry participation in skill development programs, the Ministry, under PMKVY, has prioritized industry-aligned training, apprenticeship-linked skilling initiatives, and partnerships with local industries. PMKVY promotes on-the-job training to strengthen the connection between classroom learning and workplace requirements. Industry experts are actively involved in curriculum development, ensuring alignment with current market

demands. Rojgar Melas, career counselling sessions, etc. are organized to directly link industries with skilled candidates.

(d) The Government realizes the importance of conducting entrepreneurship development programmes for different target groups who wish to become self-reliant and start their nano and micro enterprises. Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship through its Autonomous Institutes i.e National Institute for Entrepreneurship and Small Business Development (NIESBUD) and Indian Institute of Entrepreneurship (IIE) organizes various programmes, for promoting entrepreneurship amongst different target groups including those who wish to become self-reliant and start their nano and micro enterprises.

Placements/Self-employment were tracked in the Short-Term Training (STT) component in the first three versions of the PMKVY Scheme i.e. PMKVY 1.0, PMKVY 2.0 and PMKVY 3.0 implemented from FY 2015-16 to FY 2021-22. Under PMKVY 4.0 which is currently under implementation from FY 2022-23 onwards, the focus is to empower trained candidates to choose their varied career path and they are well-oriented under the scheme to make career choices. In addition, details of the trained candidates are available on SIDH portal for connecting with potential employers. Through SIDH, candidates can have access to jobs and apprenticeship opportunities.
