**NEW ROADS UNDER PMGSY**

**2852. SHRI DILIP SAIKIA:**

**Will the Minister of RURAL DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:**

- (a) the quantum of funds allocated during the last ten years under Pradhan Mantri Gramin Sadak Yojana (PMGSY), State-wise including North-east area;**
- (b) the number of new roads constructed from the said amount allocated during the said period, State-wise; and**
- (c) the number of roads constructed in the State of Assam during the year 2024-25, districtwise including Darang-Udalguri, Kamrup (Rural) and Tamalpur?**

**(a): The State-wise details of Central Funds released during last ten years and current year (as on 12.03.2025) to various States/UTs, including North Eastern States, under Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana (PMGSY) are given in Annexure-I.**

**(b): The State-wise details of roads constructed, including new connectivity roads, during last ten years and current year (as on 12.03.2025) under various verticals of PMGSY are given Annexure-II. **(c): During Financial Year 2024-25 (as on 12.03.2025), a total of 80 roads of 224 km length and 13 bridges have been constructed under various verticals of the PMGSY in the State of Assam. District-wise details are given in Annexure-III.**
