SAGARMALA YOUNG PROFESSIONAL SCHEME

Will the Minister of PORTS, SHIPPING AND WATERWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has launched a scheme called 'Sagarmala Young Professional Scheme, recently;
- (b) if so, the details thereof alongwith the aims and the objective behind the move;
- (c) the number of professionals to be hired under the said scheme and the criteria fixed for selecting the professionals;
- (d) whether any incentives are likely to be given to professionals under the scheme and if so, the details thereof; and
- (e) the steps taken/proposed to be taken by the Government to make the scheme successful?

(a) to (e) No such scheme has been launched. However, the Ministry has engaged Young Professionals for assisting senior officers in project and other technical works of the Ministry. Engagement of Young Professionals is done based on certain eligibility criteria/professional experience prescribed by the Ministry. The Young Professionals are being paid a fixed remuneration of Rs. 60000/- per month and are hired for an initial period of 2 years.
