**(a) to c) The road connecting Jagtial-Dharmaram-Peddapalli-Kalva Srirampur-Kishtampet-Tekumatla-Ramappa is a State road and development of State roads is the responsibility of the respective**

**State Government. Government keeps on receiving proposals from various State Governments/UTs, etc., including from the State of Telangana for declaration / up-gradation of State roads as National Highways (NHs). Government considers declaration of some of the State roads as NHs from time to time based on the requirements of connectivity, inter-se priority, traffic levels and synergy with PM Gati Shakti Master Plan.**
