

## **Regarding need to sanction additional modern rakes for Mumbai Suburban Railway in Maharashtra-Laid**

**SHRI SANJAY DINA PATIL (MUMBAI NORTH-EAST):** The Mumbai Suburban Railway is the lifeline of our financial capital, carrying between 75 lakh and 1 crore passengers every single day. Yet this lifeline is stretched to a breaking point. Chronic overcrowding, driven by an acute shortage of train rakes, has turned daily travel into a serious safety hazard for millions of citizens. The tragic Mumbra incident of June 2025 is a painful reminder. Two local trains crossed on a sharp curve, and due to extreme overcrowding, commuters standing on the footboards were thrown onto the tracks. Five innocent lives were lost, and more than fifteen were grievously injured. These were preventable deaths. It is our collective responsibility to ensure that such tragedies never recur. I urge the Ministry of Railways to immediately sanction additional rakes for the Mumbai suburban network, with priority given to modern rakes equipped with automatic closing doors. This single intervention will significantly reduce footboard travel and save countless lives. Mumbai's commuters deserve safety, dignity, and reliable transport. I request the Government to act with urgency.
