

**Regarding need for financial audit and modernization of Semi Conductor Laboratory (SCL) in Mohali, Punjab- laid**

**SHRI MANISH TEWARI (CHANDIGARH):** I would like to draw the attention of the Government towards the matter of urgent public importance regarding the long-pending modernisation of the Semi-Conductor Laboratory (SCL), Mohali, which has suffered decades of losses, technological obsolescence, and repeated delays in upgradation. Despite being India's earliest semiconductor fabrication facility, SCL continues to operate far below global benchmarks, reportedly still on outdated nodes and limited production capacity. There is growing concern that no comprehensive audit has been publicly disclosed on the losses, damages and recovery aftermath of the devastating 1989 fire, nor on subsequent declines in capability. Further, substantial funds allocated over the past two decades for repair, modernisation and R&D appear either under-utilised or inadequately monitored, raising questions on efficiency and oversight. Given India's ambitious semiconductor mission, it is imperative that the Government clarify the current technology node, wafer size, and production capacity of SCL; the approvals and timelines for its upgrade; and the role expected to be played by the India Semiconductor Mission. I urge the Government to conduct an independent performance and financial audit to ensure transparency, accountability, and effective utilisation of public funds to build SCL into a globally competitive facility.
