

Regarding need to release pending funds for construction of Rangaraya Medical College in Kakinada, Andhra Pradesh- Laid

SHRI TANGELLA UDAY SRINIVAS (KAKINADA): I would like to seek the urgent intervention of the Union Government for the timely completion of critical infrastructure works at Rangaraya Medical College, Kakinada. During my recent inspection of the college, I reviewed the ongoing construction of the PG and UG hostels. I found that only 35% of the PG Ladies Hostel (G+4) and 15% of the PG Male Hostel (G+3) have been completed. The primary reason for this delay is the slow disbursement of sanctioned funds. As per the Detailed Project Report, the Central share is ₹33.12 crore, yet only ₹8.28 crore has been released so far, leaving essential works stalled and directly affecting postgraduate training and student facilities. India is expanding health infrastructure nationwide. In Andhra Pradesh, the NDA Government advances with holistic development. I urge the Centre to release pending funds for RMC to strengthen medical education in the Godavari region.
