

**Regarding need to expedite completion of Phase-II work on Mallavaram-Bhopal-Bhilwara-Vijaipur Natural Gas Pipeline Project-Laid**

**SHRI VAMSI KRISHNA GADDAM (PEDDAPALLE):** I hereby to draw the urgent attention of the Government to the delay in completing Phase-II of the MallavaramBhopalBhilwaraVijaipur (MBBVPL) Natural Gas Pipeline, which passes through Manthani, Ramagundam, Mancherial, and Bellampally in Peddapalli district. Phase-I of the project has already been completed, and gas supply to RFCL Ramagundam has commenced. However, Phase-II, which includes the spur lines and tap-off points on the MancherialBellampallyNagpur stretch, remains pending for a long time. This delay is denying our region access to natural gas for industries, the CNG/PNG network, transport needs, and MSME expansion. The availability of natural gas is essential for reducing energy costs, improving industrial competitiveness, and attracting new investments to the district. Completion of Phase-II would also enable the development of a dedicated Gas-Based Industrial Cluster in Peddapalli, creating jobs and supporting the economic aspirations of the local population. I therefore urge the Government to take immediate steps to complete the remaining portion of the pipeline, establish the required tap-off points in our district, and ensure timely gas availability for industrial and public use. This project has the potential to significantly boost employment and industrial growth in Peddapalli, and its early completion is essential.
