

**Regarding need for establishment of `Mappila Kala Kendram Arabic and Urdu Literature Center of Excellence` at Charummoodu in Alappuzha district, Kerala**

**SHRI KODIKUNNIL SURESH (MAVELIKKARA):** I wish to draw the attention of the Honble Minister of Culture and Minister of Education to the urgent need for establishing Mappila Kala Kendram Arabic and Urdu Literature Center of Excellence at Charummoodu, Mavelikkara, Kerala. The Mappila community has made remarkable contributions to Indias composite culture through its unique traditions of Arabi-Malayalam and Urdu literature, music, and spiritual expressions. Despite this rich legacy, there is a significant gap in institutional mechanisms to preserve, study, and promote these art forms, manuscripts, and oral traditions. Charummoodu, situated at the cultural intersection of Alappuzha and Kollam districts, has historically served as a nurturing centre for Mappilappattu, Arabi-Malayalam literature, qasida recitations, and other traditional art forms. Establishing a Center of Excellence would enable systematic research, documentation, training, translation, publication, and cultural exchange. It would also help conserve rare manuscripts and oral histories that are currently at risk of being lost. The proposed Kendram may be developed under the Ministry of Culture or in partnership with institutions such as the Kerala Folklore Academy, Sahitya Akademi, or the National Council for Promotion of Urdu Language. I urge the Government to consider this initiative at the earliest to safeguard and promote Indias diverse literary and cultural heritage.
