There is a very important matter that is quoted inside this article that I have authenticated, which speaks about the reaction of the Prime Minister. (*Interruptions*)

HON. CHAIRPERSON: I am once again requesting you to please restrict yourself to the speech of the hon. President.

HON. CHAIRPERSON: I am requesting LOP to please restrict himself to the speech of the hon. President.

THE MINISTER OF PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS; AND MINISTER OF MINORITY AFFAIRS (SHRI KIREN RIJU): Let us not mislead the House. Let us clear the confusion. Today also, I have requested both Venugopal ji and Gaurav ji. We are patiently waiting to listen to the hon. Leader of the Opposition on the matter which was referred to just now, yesterday, the Chair had given a ruling on the paper

which he has authenticated and which has been tabled in the House. But what I am saying is, when a ruling has already been given on a matter which he referred to yesterday, he cannot quote the same matter again on the pretext of making a reference indirectly. He cannot refer to the same matter.

Please continue with your speech. We are waiting. *(Interruptions)* But please avoid referring to a matter which has been settled. *(Interruptions)*

SHRI K. C. VENUGOPAL (ALAPPUZHA): Sir, hon. Parliamentary Affairs Minister is trying to mislead the House. Of course, he called on us, me and Gaurav Gogoi. *(Interruptions)*

HON. CHAIRPERSON: When hon. LOP is standing, you are speaking.

SHRI K. C. VENUGOPAL: Sir, I want to give a clarification. *(Interruptions)* Please allow me to give a clarification. *(Interruptions)* Please allow me to speak. *(Interruptions)*

This is central, as you have seen, to our Budget. All I am saying is that I want to make a statement about what happened between China and India and how our Prime Minister reacted to it. Why am I being stopped?

Sir, in eastern Ladakh, there was a conflict. Our soldiers were killed. *(Interruptions)*
