

Need to provide stoppage of various express trains at Gudiyattam -Town Railway Station in Tamil Nadu-Laid

SHRI D. M. KATHIR ANAND (VELLORE): I wish to draw the attention of the Government to the Gudiyattam Town Railway station which is one of the prominent Hubs and spoke node model Railway station for daily train travel passengers and is being under capacity utilized in last 70+years. For their daily train travel, passengers in and around Gudiyattam Town and villages (350 village peripherals) struggle to go to board the train from nearby stations. Large number of industrial, labour, workers from Gudiyattam Town and its surroundings are working in Chennai, Kanchipuram, Bengaluru and Coimbatore regions. I on behalf of the people of my Vellore Parliamentary constituency request the Honorable Minister to facilitate and make arrangements for trains viz. 1. Lalbagh Express - 12607/12608 2. Trivandrum Express - 12695/12696 3. Kovai Express 12675/12676 4. Brindavan Express - 12639/12640 to stop and halt at Gudiyattam Town Railway station. Both onward and downward journey platform tracks are located in main line only. I request the Hon'ble Minister to consider the proposal of new Express trains, daily between Salem Junction and Chennai Central via Vellore, Gudiyattam, Ambur, Vaniyambadi, Jolarpet. Express starts at 4.30 am from Salem to reach Chennai at 9.50 am and starts at 4.30 pm from Chennai and reach Salem at 9.50 pm. This daily Express train would serve the people of Tamil Nadu in the best possible manner.
