

### **Regarding restoring the job of teachers who joined before 2011**

श्री सौमित्र खान (बिष्णुपुर): Thank you Chairperson Madam. The issue I want to raise is not only significant for West Bengal but for the youth and educated people of the entire India. There is a deadlock with teachers all over India. My request is that if those who joined the services before 2011 are expelled again as per the order of the Supreme Court, then what is the real fault of these teachers? The trial has been going on for 15 years and these teachers got jobs after studying hard for it. To exclude those who got jobs, the Supreme Court gave an order on September 1 saying they have to pass the exam. There was no TET exam back then. They got the chance by clearing the exam conducted by the state government. More than 20 lakh teachers are stuck like this across the country. My request is that more than 75 thousand such teachers are facing this problem in West Bengal too. This is a very important issue, if we do not pay attention to it, it can be a terrible danger. I request the Union Education Minister to take immediate action on this and take steps to ensure that they are restored in their jobs.
