- (a) the description of National Technical Textiles Mission (NTTM);
- (b) the details and list of applications received under various categories under NTTM;
- (c) the total funds allocated, released and utilized under fan function component of National Technical Textiles Mission (NTTM) since its inception;
- (d) whether there are gaps between the total mission outlay of Rs. 1,480 crore and the actual utilization reported as of December 2025 and if so, the reasons therefor;
- (e) the steps taken by the Government to ensure that unutilized funds are re-prioritized for Medium, Small and Micro Enterprise (MSME) technology adoption and the establishment of regional testing laboratories; and
- (f) whether the Government has provided any technical or financial assistance to MSMEs in Chhattisgarh for the indigenous production of Geotextiles, considering their high demand in the State's extensive mining and road construction projects?

**(a) & (b):** National Technical Textiles Mission (NTTM) was launched in the year 2020 with a fund outlay of Rs. 1,480 crore. The Mission focuses on research & innovation in the field of specialty fibres like Carbon fibre, Aramid fibre, Nylon, Composites etc. as well as in different segments of Technical Textiles such as geo textiles, agro textiles, medical textiles etc. and indigenous development of machinery; promoting awareness amongst users; enhancing India's exports of technical textiles; and creating human resources with requisite skills. More than 1100 applications have been received under various components of NTTM.

**(c) & (d):** Out of the total outlay of Rs. 1,480 crore, projects/interventions worth about Rs. 748 core has been allocated, of which Rs. 506.73 crore has been released as on December 2025 under various components of NTTM. Fund utilization in the research projects is a dynamic process from commencement to logical conclusion of defined milestones. The timeline of majority of the research projects is 2 to 3 years from date of sanction and funds is released in installments based on achieving project milestones as per the Detailed Project Report (DPR).

**(e):** The interventions under NTTM are structured around four core components i.e. Research, Innovation & Development; Promotion & Market Development; Export Promotion; Education, Training & Skill Development and projects worth Rs. 748 crore has been allotted so far under these components. Further, industry stakeholders including MSMEs are collaborated in the implementation of research and innovation projects under NTTM for technology adoption and commercialization of deliverables of the research projects.

**(f):** No, Sir. However, in the field of geotextiles, a total of 22 research projects have been approved under the Mission.
