

**Regarding need to expedite establishment of Rural Self Employment Training Institute and Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Kendras under PMKVY in Konaseema district of Andhra PradeshLaid**

**SHRI G. M. HARISH BALAYOGI (AMALAPURAM):** There exists a substantial skilling infrastructure deficit in Dr. B. R. Ambedkar Konaseema district, Andhra Pradesh, which has significantly constrained the implementation of Central skill development initiatives. Although flagship programmes such as PMKVY, DDU-GKY and RSETIs are designed to create a job-ready workforce, their intended outcomes are not materialising in the district due to the absence of functional training centres and the lack of institutional capacity to operationalise them. A new RSETI has been sanctioned, but site finalisation remains pending. There is still no operational PMKK or PMKVY centre even after the roll-out of PMKVY 4.0 with stronger industry and placement linkages. Training under DDU-GKY is practically inactive due to lack of basic training infrastructure. The district also remains the only one in Andhra Pradesh without a Government ITI, further widening the skill gap and limiting the availability of trained manpower. I request the Government to urgently operationalise the sanctioned RSETI, establish PMKK and PMKVY centres and prioritise the creation of a Government ITI in the district. Strengthening the district-level skilling ecosystem is essential to ensure equitable access to employment-linked opportunities and to enable the youth of Dr. B. R. Ambedkar Konaseema District to contribute meaningfully to national growth.
