

**Regarding release of special Central funds under AMRUT 2.0 for the infrastructure development for damage caused by heavy rains and Cyclone Montha**

**DR. KADIYAM KAVYA (WARANGAL):** Hon. Madam Chairperson, I draw the urgent attention of the House to the devastating damage caused by heavy rains and Cyclone Montha in October, 2025 across Greater Warangal Municipal Corporation limits. Over 200 mm rainfall submerged 45 colonies including Shivanagar and DK Nagar, and key roads -- Pothana Road, Bhadrakali-Polytechnic stretch, Mulugu Road, Bondi Vagu and the 80 feet road at Pochamma Maidan -- have been washed away, turning into rivers of slush with deep craters. Nearly 1,200 residents were evacuated to 12 relief camps. Incomplete drainage works under AMRUT and Smart Cities Mission -- only 66 per cent of Rs. 1,800 crore completed -- exposed systemic failure in planning and maintenance.

I urge the hon. Minister of Housing and Urban Affairs to release special Central funds under AMRUT 2.0 for immediate resurfacing and flood-resilient repairs of internal roads by March 2026, order a high-level audit of GWMC infrastructure and integrate real-time monitoring, and announce an immediate relief package of Rs. 100 crore for road restoration. Warangal, a heritage Smart City, deserves resilient roads, not recurring ruin. Thank you.
