(a) & (b): Government of India have no specific scheme to extend the high school education specifically in the remote areas. However, a scheme was started in 1985-86 to establish, on an average, one Navodaya Vidyalaya in each district in the country with the objective of providing good quality modern Vidyalayas are fully residential, co-educational institutions providing upto Senior Secondary stage. Education in these schools including boarding and loading, text-books, uniforms etc. is free for all students, 410 schools covering as many districts in 30 States and UTs has so far been opened with about 1.21 lakh students on rolls.
