(a) Yes Sir.

(b) & (c) There is an in-principle understanding between India and Russia that a part of Rupee Repayment Funds owed by India to Russia may be used for Russian investment in joint ventures in India. The details in this regard, including the guidelines, areas for such investment and related modalities have not been finalised yet. Operationalisation of such an agreement for investment can have a positive impact on the bilateral cooperation between the two countries.
