- (b) the action proposed to be taken thereon and the time by which the said course is likely to be started therein?

(a)&(b): The requests for upgradation of Kendriya Vidyalayas from the academic session 2000-01 are being received in KVS and a clear picture will emerge after the declaration of class X results since some more similar requests are likely to be received after the declaration of the class X results. The upgradation is permitted subject to the availability of budget provision, adequate number of eligible students for the stream and infrastructure facilities with the vidyalayas. In so far as NVS is concerned, as a matter of policy, JNVs are started at class VI level and one class is added every year. All JNVs are upgraded to 10+2 stage subject to availability of infrastructure.
