- (e) if not, the reasons thereof?

(a) to (e) No sir. No Scheme has been formulated to solve the water problem in the drought prone areas by way of cloud seeding. Many countries including india, have carried out experiments in cloud seeding but these are only at the research stage. There is no proven method of creating artificial rain through cloud seeding, particularly in the tropical regions where there are warm clouds.
