- (a) whether any study was conducted by the Delhi Traffic Police to identify the schools in the Capital where the chances of accident are much more as compared to other schools;
- (b) if so, the outcome thereof; and
- (c) the corrective measures taken by the Government in this regard?

Answer

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (CH. VIDYASAGAR RAO)

(a) to (c): Delhi Traffic Police have identified 227 roads and bus stops which are used extensively by school going children and deployed 181 traffic police personnel at such vantage points to ensure their safety. The Delhi Traffic Police have also undertaken several programmes to educate school children and teachers on road safety.
