## Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether spare parts are purchased by Jamalpur Locomotive factory (Eastern Railway) for repairing and maintenance of diesel engines and wagons;
- (b) if so, the details of purchase made during 1997-98, 1998-99 and 1999-2000 so far;
- (c) whether the Government are aware that Jamalpur factory makes large scale purchase of gigantic machines also;
- (d) if so, the details of such machines purchased during above period;
- (e) whether it takes three years' time to purchase and install these machines in the factory;
- (f) if so, whether these machines are sold as scrap even before they are put to any use; (g) whether the Government propose to order any C.B.I. probe to investigate the matter; and (h) if so, by when and if not, the reasons therefore?

1997-98 - Rs. 128.43 Lakhs 1998-99 - Rs. 187.55 Lakhs 1999-00 - Rs. 106.93 Lakhs

- (c) Jamalpur Factory does not make purchase of gigantic machines directly.
