- (a) whether combination of Anti-TB drug and vitamin has been declared health hazard;
- (b) if so, the reasons for selling it in the country;
- (c) whether any enquiry has been conducted in this regard;
- (d) if so, the outcome thereof; and
- (e) the action being taken by the Government against the responsible officials?

(a)&(b) The fixed dose combination of vitamins with anti TB drugs, except the combination of Isoniazide, an anti TB drug, with vitamin B-6, were banned for use in the country on grounds of irrationality with effect from 23.7.1983. Use of vitamin B-6 has been permitted in anti-TB formulations containing Isoniazid to prevent neuritis during the treatment of TB.However, this combination is not used in the National TB Control Programme.
