- (a) the details of the assistance provided by the foreign agencies to the Government for the eradication of Cancer in the country;
- (b) the details of the amount spent during the last three years for the prevention and cure of Cancer;
- (c) the results achieved so far in this regard for the said period;
- (d) whether the Government propose to set up special wards in hospitals for the treatment of such patients;
- (e) if so, the details thereof;
- (f) whether the Government propose to provide assistance to the State for opening separate cancer hospitals/centres for the treatment of cancer;
- (g) if so, the details thereof; and
- (h) if not, the reasons therefor?

**Answer**

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (SHRI A. RAJA)

- (a): In the current biennium 2000-01 approximately US \$ 6,00,000 have been allocated by WHO for various activities under National Cancer Control Programme. In the last biennium 1998-99, the allocation was US \$ 3,53,000.
- (b): Amount spent during the biennium 1998-99 is at Annexure-I.
- (c): The activities were carried out successfully.
- (d): No such proposal is planned or pending.
- (e): Not applicable.
- (f) to (h): The Central Government has a scheme to provide assistance to different States for prevention and treatment of cancer.
