(a) whether the Government propose to impose certain restrictions on the unchecked immigration into the Islands to prevent breakdown in the civil amenities as the present population has already exceeded the carrying capacity of the Island determined by various experts appointed by the Government;

(b) if so, the details thereof;

(c) whether there is any proposal of amending the Andaman Land Regulation of British vintage;

(d) if so, the details thereof;

(e) whether Voter's Identity Cards, could become the basic Identity document of every citizen of Andamans; and

(f) if so, the details thereof?

(a)&(b): The Andaman and Nicobar Administration have taken several steps to control unrestricted migration of population to the Islands. These include restrictions on infulx of outside labour, introduction of differential ship fare for islanders and non-islanders, maintenance of register containing the particulars of the inhabitants at the Panchayat level and removal of encroachments.

(c)&(d): Yes, Sir. The proposal relates to imposition of restrictions on transfer of land by an occupancy tenant to a person other that original inhabitants and settlers.

(e)&(f): The Andaman and Nicobar Administration have included a Plan Scheme in the 9th Five Year Plan for issue of Islanders Identity Cards to all bonafide residents of Andaman and Nicobar Islands which is intended to serve as the basic document for identification of the islanders.
