During the year 2002-2003, Public Sector Oil Marketing Companies (OMCs) have the plan to set up 97 new LPG dispensing stations in the country in addition to 49 planned to be commissioned during 2001-2002. Similarly, Mahanagar Gas Limited (MGL) and Indraprastha Gas Limited (IGL) have the plan to set up 21 and 16 new CNG stations in Mumbai and Delhi respectively during the same period. However, the commissioning of these LPG/CNG stations depend on the availability of site and other necessary statutory approvals.
