CAMPAIGN IN HYDERABAD ON CHILD LABOUR BY ILO

Will the Minister of LABOUR be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the International Labour Organisation has launched a campaign in Hyderabad under which child labour will be motivated to go to schools by providing them incentives;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the time by which the motive of this campaign is likely to be implemented in the country?

Answer

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF LABOUR (SHRI ASHOK PRADHAN)

(a)&(b): As per the information received from International Labour Organisation, no such campaign has been launched in Hyderabad. However, under the ILO-IPEC's Andhra Pradesh State Based Project, a mini programme for mobilizing child labour in 40 slums of Hyderabad's old city and admitting them in schools is being implemented. In addition, Hindupur (Anantapur District) Kuppam (Chittoor District) Markapur (Prakasam District), Thandur and Maldekar mandals of Mahabubnagar District and Visakhapatnam city are also being covered under the project at present.

(c): There are no immediate plans for implementing the campaign in the other parts of the country.
