However, the details of proposals received from the people's representatives in the recent past and the action taken on them are given below:
- 1 Kanchipuram-Tindivanam It is not considered necessary to New Line take up this project at this stage.
- 2 Plani-Satyamangalam New $\;$ It is not considered necessary to Line $\;$ take up this project at this stage.
- 3 Gauge Conversion of Both the projects have been Tirupati-Katpadi sanctioned .
- 4 Thanjavure-Nagore Gauge This is a sanctioned work and will Conversion be progressed as per the availability of resources.
- 5 Doubling of Chennai- It is not considered necessary to Kanniyakumari take up this project at this stage.
