THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF CHEMICALS & FERTILIZERS (SHRI RAMESH BAIS)

(a) to (c): The Pharmaceutical Research & Development Committee (PRDC)vas constituted in March, 1999 to recommend measures to strengthen the research & development capability of the pharmaceutical industry in India and to identify the support required by Indian Pharmaceutical companies to undertake domestic Research & Development. The Committeehas submitted its report to the Government. To achieve these objectives, the Committee has recommended, interalia, the establishment of a Drug Development Promotion Foundation, to promote such R&D.For this purpose, it has recommended setting up of a fund called the `Pharmaceutical R&D Support Fund` to be administered by the Drug Development PromotiorFoundation. It has also suggested several fiscal and non-fiscal measures. The Government is generally supportive of the approach suggested by the Committee.
