- (b) if so, the details in this regard?

(a) & (b): Indian Farmers Fertiliser Cooperative Limited (IFFCO), Krishalsharti Cooperative Limited (KRIBHCO) and Indian Potash Limited (IPL) in collaboration with Tokio Marine and Fire Insurance Company, Japan haveincorporated a joint venture company under the name of IFFCO-TOKIO Generalnsurance Company Limited (ITGI) on 8th September, 2000. The company obtained a certificate to commence insurance business from the Registrar of Companies and also a licence from the Insurance Regulatory and Development Authority on 4th December, 2000.

The Joint-Venture partners alongwith their share holding include IFFCO(49%), Tokio-Marine and Fire Insurance Company (26%), KRIBHCO (20%) and Indian Potash Limited (5%).

This insurance company is in operation since its incorporation.
