## Will the Minister of PETROLEUM AND NATURAL GAS be pleased to state:

(a) whether compressed natural gas is being used as fuel at cremation grounds in some parts of the country;

(b) if so, whether the Government has any plan to encourage use of CNG for crematoriums in the country on a large scale;

(c) if so, the details in this regard; and

(d) if not, the reasons therefor?

## Answer

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF PETROLEUM & NATURAL GAS (SHRI SANTOSH KUMAR GANGWAR)

(a) No, Sir. However, Mahanagar Gas Limited (MGL) is discussing for gas supply to one crematorium at Mulund, Mumbai for which pipeline has already been laid.

(b) to (d) Presently, natural gas is being supplied for domestic, commercial and CNG purposes in Mumbai, Delhi and some other cities in Gujarat. In such places natural gas can be utilized as a clean fuel in crematoriums also. The initiative in this regard has to be taken by the respective State Governments and Municipal bodies.
