#### Will the Minister of WATER RESOURCES be pleased to state:

(a) whether the Union Government have recentlyasked the Karnataka Government to furnish details of expenditure on different irrigation projects which require funds, to complete them within Ninth Five Year Plan;

(b) if so, whether the Karnataka Government has furnished those details;

(c) the amount estimated to be required to complete the incomplete irrigation projects in Karnataka; and

(d) the steps taken by the Government to provide funds to Karnataka to complete these irrigation projects?

## Answer

#### THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF WATER RESOURCES (SMT. BIJOYA CHAKRAVARTY)

(a) to (d) Irrigation being a State subject, Irrigation Projectsare taken up for implementation by the State Governments themselves out of their own resources and as per their own priorities. Ministry of Water Resources has requested the Government of Karnataka to draw an action plan for completion of certain approved Ongoing Major and Medium Irrigation Projects which have been spilling over from plan to plan and are at present in advanced stages of construction and can be completed during the IX Plan itself. A statement as furnished by the Government of Karnataka giving therein details of projects proposed for completion during IX Plan period alongwith balance amount required to complete these incomplete irrigation projects during IX Five Year Plan and source of funding is enclosed.
