(a) whether the Indian Airlines are facing shortage of staff;

(b) if so, the details of posts lying vacant as on date; and

(c) the steps taken to fill up these vacancies?

(a), (b) and (c): In Indian Airlines, there is a shortage of manpower in some Departments, particularly operating Departments. The aircraft utilization and the number of stations on the network have gone up in the last three years. In order to take care of these requirements, as also normal attrition, vacancies are released from time to time.
