### Will the Minister of COMMUNICATIONS AND INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY be pleased to state:

(a) whether TRAI has recently announced new tariffs for different categories of land-line, WLL and cell phone users;

(b) if so, the details thereof;

(c) the actual impact of the recommendations on subscribers, particularly those in rural areas covered by village panchayats;

(d) whether the Government have accepted the new rates fixed by TRAI; and

(e) if so, the details thereof?

## Answer

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF COMMUNICATIONS AND INFORMATION TECHNOLOGYMATI SUMITRA MAHAJAN)

(a) Yes, Sir. The Telecom Regulatory Authority of India (TRAI) vide its 24th amendment to Telecom Tariff Order (TTO) 1999, has announced new tariffs on 24th January 2003 in respect of land-line, WLL and cell phones which will come into effect from 01.04.2003

(b) The details of the major items of tariff for land-lines, WLL (limited mobility) and cellular service are in the Annexure.

(c) The actual impact of TRAI's recent tariff on subscribers is not known as the tariff is to come into effect from 01.04.2003.

(d) & (e): As per the TRAI Act 1997, as amended in 2000, the power of tariff fixation for telecom services is mandated to the TRAI, which is now the only Authority for exercising this power. Service providers (including PSUs), however, have the flexibility of making their own tariff packages within the ceilings/floors prescribed by TRAI.
