(e) the total money sanctioned and spent under the project?

(a) & (b) Yes, Sir. Four regional Rehabilitaton Centres (RRCs) for persons withspinal injuries and orthopaedic disabilities are approved to be set up at Mohali (Pnjab), Bareilly (Uttar Pradesh), Cuttack (Orissa) and Jabalpur (Madhya Pradesh).

(c) No, Sir.

(e) A total amount of Rs.9.35 crores has been released for the RRCs so far.
