(e) the extent to which the Union Government have succeeded in this matter?

(a) & (b) Yes, Sir. The States of Arunachal Pradesh, Meghalaya, Mizoram, Nagaland,UTs of Andaman & Nicobar Islands and Lakshadweep have not implemented the recommendations of the Mandal Commission as there is no Backward Classpopulation in these States/UTs.

(c),(d)&(e) Yes, Sir. The recommendations of the Mandal Commission had beenforwarded to the States/UTs for taking appropriate action for their implementation. All the States/UTs except the above mentioned States/UTs are implementing the recommendations of the Mandal Commission.
