Will the Minister of TEXTILES be pleased to state:

(a) whether the Government have decided to increase their share under the Textile Centre Infrastructure Development Scheme; and

(b) if so, the details thereof alongwith the reasons therefore ?

Answer

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF TEXTILES (SHRI BASANAGOUDA R. PATIL (YATNAL)

(a) & (b) Yes, Sir. The Government has announced (in December 2002) modifications in the scope and funding pattern of TCIDS with a view to bringing in urgency in implementation of the Scheme. The central assistance under the scheme was earlier allowed upto 50% of the critical components of the project subject to a maximum of Rs. 20 crores for each area. Under the modified scheme, the central assistance would be available to the extent of 100% of the critical components of the project in respect of Common Effluent Treatment Plant, improving water supply and drainage facilities and construction of crÃ⁻ che building for apparel units, whereas the other components would be funded on 75:25 basis between centre and states/reputed agencies concerned.
