Will the Minister of TEXTILES be pleased to state:

(a) whether the Government are aware that a large quantum of handloom textiles have stagnated due to lack of sufficient marketing facilities in Tamil Nadu;

(b) if so, whether the families depending upon this industry are facing unprecedented pecuniary situation; and

(c) if so, the steps the Government propose to ameliorate the sufferings of these people?

Answer

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF TEXTILES (SHRI BASANAGOUDA R. PATIL (YATNAL)

(a) No, Sir. However, the Government of Tamil Nadu has informed that due to a recession in the textile market, there had been an accumulation of handloom goods in the State. The Government of Tamil Nadu has reported that the Weavers' Cooperative Societies and the Tamil Nadu Handloom Weavers' Cooperative Society Ltd. (COOPTEX) have liquidated the handloom stock to a large extent and the stock of Rs.452.75 crore on 1.4.2002 has been brought down to Rs.271.90 crore by 31.1.2003.

(b) No such report has been received from the Government of Tamil Nadu.

(c) In view of (b) above, does not arise.
