(a):As a result of exploration efforts, Oil and Natural Gas Corporation Limited(ONGC) and Oil India Limited have accretedround 175 MMt of in-place hydrocarbons during 1996-99.

(b): Given the inherent uncertainty of exploration and production activities of hydrocarbons, for any site with potential for oil and gas, projections for factors such as economic feasibility, production and production cost cannot be made unless the well is actually drilled and tested.

(c) The state-wise finds discovered by ONGC during 1996-99 are given below:
