(a) to (d): No, Sir. However, a section of press recently carried isolated news reports in which the overcharging by the pre-paid booths was alleged. The allegations in these news reports were not supported by any specific instances. Nevertheless, the inquiry made by Delhi Police revealed that certain authorized components of the charges levied were mistakenly projected as illegal collections in the news reports.
