Answer

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI I.D.SWAMI)

(a): The States of Jammu & Kashmir, Himachal Pradesh, Uttaranchal, Sikkim and Arunachal Pradesh share their borders with China. There is no proposal with the Government of India regarding sealing of the Indo-China Border. The integrity of this border is being maintained by regular patrolling etc. by the security forces.
