(a),(b)&(c) Priority works for abatement of pollution of river at Pamba and Sabrimala have been sanctioned at an estimated cost of Rs. 18.45 crore in May, 2003 under National River Conservation Plan of the Ministry. The cost of the project is to be shared between the Centre and the State Government in the ratio of 70:30.
