PRODUCTION OF HEAVY INDUSTRIES UNDER LIBERALIZATION POLICY

- (a) the total amount spent on setting up of heavy industries in different parts of the country during the last three years under liberalization policy, State-wise and industry-wise;

- (c) the details of such industries in which the production work is going on; and
- (d) the dates by which these industries started their production?

(a) to (d): Consequent upon liberalization and delicensing of non-strategic sectors, promoters take their own decision on cost and location for setting up industrial units. However, so far as public sector units under the Department of Heavy Industry are concerned, no new unit has been set up in the country during the last three years.
