(a) to (e). World Bank has not given assistance for implementation of modern and sustainable hazardous waste management in the country. However, a Japanese grant was made available by the World Bank for conduct of two studies on hazardous waste management as part of a series of feasibility studies for formulation of a project for World Bank assistance on Industrial Safety and Disaster Prevention. The above feasibility studies have been completed.
