DAILY ALLOWANCE TO CREW MEMBERS ABROAD

Will the Minister of CIVIL AVIATION be pleased to state:

- (a) the rate of Daily Allowance (D.A.) being paid to Indian Airlines cabin crew when staying abroad on duty; and
- (b) whether it is paid in accordance with the instructions issued by Ministry of External Affairs; and
- (c) if not, the reasons therefor?

Answer

MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRY OF CIVIL AVIATION (SHRI RAJIV PRATAP RUDY)

(a): No Daily Allowance is paid to cabin crew when staying abroad on duty as transport and accommodation is provided by Indian Airlines. They are only entitled for payment of US\$ 20 as `out of pocket expenses` in local currency whenever they are required to night stop at foreign stations.

(b) and (c): No, Sir. The employees of Indian Airlines are governed by instructions issued by the Company.
