(a) whether the World Bank and Japanese Bank for International Cooperation have evinced interest in funding the Godavari Basin Projects proposed to be taken up by the Andhra Pradesh Government; (

(b) if so, the names of projects along with assistance received from said international agencies; and (

(c) by when the work on these projects are likely to commence?

Answer

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF WATER RESOURCES (SHRIMATI BHOYA CHAKRAVARTY)

(a) No project falling in Godavari basin of Andhra Pradesh has been posed to the World Bank and Japanese Bank for International Cooperation. However, Sriram Sagar Project which is in Godavari basin is already under implementation as one of the components of the World Bank aided Andhra Pradesh Irrigation Project-III. The project is scheduled for completion by 31.7.2004.
