(a) & (b): No survey has been carried out to assess the growth of air passengers in the country. However, a study for passenger traffic forecast has been carried out by Airports Authority of India.

According to the study, the International and Domestic Passenger Traffic is expected to grow at the rate of 6% and 5% respectively till the end of 11th Five Year Plan (2011-12).
