- (a) whether the Government have a proposal to allot flats for slum dwellers in Delhi;
- (b) if so, the areas in Delhi where these flats are being constructed for the slum dwellers; and
- (c) the amount earmarked/released for the purpose?

Answer

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF URBAN DEVELOPMENT & POVERTY ALLEVIATION (SHRI PON RADHAKR)

(a)to(c): Both Slum & JJ Department of Municipal Corporation of Delhi(MCD) and Delhi Development Authority (DDA) have reported that they do not have any such proposal to allot flats to slum dwellers in Delhi. However, the DDA, as a pilot project, has shifted the slums of Motia Khan by providing flats at Rohini.
