CREATION OF ADDITIONAL POLICE POST

Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government propose to create additional police posts in the areas falling near the Indo-Nepal border;
- (b) whether any such proposal from the Government of Bihar is pending with the Union Government;
- (c) if so, the time by which it is likely to be cleared; and
- (d) if not, the reasons therefor?

Answer

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (I.D.SWAMI)

- (a): The State Governments of Uttar Pradesh, Bihar, West Bengal and Sikkim have proposals to create police posts on the Indo-Nepal border.
- (b): A comprehensive proposal from the Government of Bihar, which inter-alia includes the creation of additional police posts by the State Government, has been submitted to the Central Government.
- (c)&(d): It is not possible to indicate any time frame by which the proposal is likely to be cleared.
