LAYING OF NEW RAILWAY LINES IN HARYANA

Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of the new railway lines laid during the last three years in Haryana and expenditure incurred thereon;
- (b) the details of the surveys conducted for laying of new railway lines during the above period and expenditure incurred thereon;
- (c) whether there is any proposal to construct new railway lines from Yamuna Nagar (Haryana) to Punta Sahib (Himachal Pradesh), Yamuna Nagar to Chandigarh and Yamuna Nagar to Kurukshetra; and
- (d) if so, the details and the present status thereof?

Answer

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI DIGVIJAY SINGH)

(a): No new railway line has been laid in Haryana during the last three years.

(b): The details of the surveys conducted are as under:-

- (i) New broad gauge line from Rewari to Rohtak.
- (ii) New broad gauge line from Kalka to Parwanoo.
- (iii) New broad gauge line from Panipat to Meerut.
- (iv) Linking Bijwasan with Bahadurgarh via Gummanhera - Hasanpur- Jaffarpur.

Total expenditure incurred on these surveys was Rs. 9.96 lakhs. (c)&(d): No, Sir. However, a survey for a new broad gauge line from Chandigarh to Dehradun via Jagadhari (Yamuna Nagar) and Paonta Sahib is being carried out.
